Alpine Responsibility Code
 These are elements of risk that common sense and personal judgement can help reduce. Regardless of how you decide to use the slopes, always show courtesy to others. Please adhere to the code listed below and share with others the responsibility for a safe and enjoyable experience.

- 1 Always stay in control. You can be held liable to an injured skier or snowboarder.
- 2 People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to pass safely.
- 3 Do not use your skis or snowboard as projectiles.
- 4 Do not ski or snowboard under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- 5 Do not ski or snowboard on lifts or in areas of lift activity, regardless of how you are attached to the lift.
- 6 Always use proper technique to help prevent injury to yourself.
- 7 There are no dry or groomed areas and no "safe" areas.
- 8 Keep off closed trails and closed areas.
- 9 Do not ski or snowboard in areas of lift activity, regardless of how you are attached to the lift.
- 10 You must have sufficient physical fitness, ability and knowledge to ski or snowboard safely. If you are unsure, ask for help. Do not ski or snowboard if you are injured or if you are under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
