Shopping & Dining



Getting to Fernie, BC

Fernie is situated in the heart of the Canadian Rocky Mountains in south-eastern British Columbia. The nearest major airport is Calgary International (YYC) with a drive time of 3 hours. Connecting flights from Calgary and Vancouver International (YVR) to Cranbrook Airport (YXC) are available with a drive time of 1 hour. #FernieStoke Ski Shuttle service operates between the ski resort, town and local accommodations on a regular basis.



