



Mini Griz Rangers Camp

FAQ: Summer 2023

What is the cost? How long is the camp?

4-day camps are \$214 per child (+GST). Each day the camps are 3 hrs from 10:30 am – 1:30 pm
Minimum four children for the camp to run.

The camp leader will be ready to greet you at 10:15 am at the winter Childcare Centre, next to the summer bike rental pick up area.

What are the ages and dates for the camps?

Mini Griz Ranger Camps are for children aged 3-5 years old, who are potty trained.

The camps dates are: June 27-30 (Tues-Fri)

July 3-6, 10-13, 17-20, 24-27, 31-Aug 3

August 7-10, 14-17, 21-24, 28-31

Where/when do I show up?

Please arrive at 10:15 am, at least 15 minutes before on the first day of camp. The camp leader will ask for emergency contact details and any other important information about your child. Please label all personal belongings.

Do parents/guardians need to sign waivers?

Yes. Anyone aged 15 and under will need a parent/guardian to sign waivers on their behalf. Two waivers per child are required - an event and parent consent waiver. Below is the link to the online waivers. Please sign the waiver before the day of the camp:

What is included in the camp? What should I bring?

Prices include camp and lift tickets. Please make sure your child is prepared for all-mountain weather with plenty of layers. We suggest a hydration pack/water, lunch and snacks, sunscreen, insect repellent, rain jacket, extra clothing, good hiking shoes. No open-toed/heeled shoes.

What activities are covered in the camps?

The camps are based around British Columbia Parks Sensing the World Around Us program. We will teach the children about respecting wildlife and learning about all the different elements that make up our environment, with activities such as scavenger hunts and digging for treasure.

Are there any COVID-19 Health and Safety rules?

Absolutely! Staff and guests are to adhere to the social distancing policy of 6 feet or 2 metres at all times. The staff will verbally conduct a health assessment questionnaire of each child/parent at the start of the camp. The questions are in place to screen for COVID-19 symptoms. The camp will be postponed if any of the staff feel it is unsafe to continue.

Will I have to wait long in the lift line during the camp?

No. The Summer Adventure School has a priority line to get up the lift quickly. The camp leader will follow lift loading instructions each time loading the lift. Your child must be 4'7" (140 cm) to load the lift on their own. The camp leader can assist two children per lift ride and more if they are in the same family bubble. Please call in advance to talk to booking agents if you have any further questions regarding camp policies.

What happens if I need to reschedule or cancel my child's camp?

The following refund/cancellation policies apply:

- Full refund when notice is given at least 24 hours prior to the start of the program.
- \$50 (plus GST) cancellation/re-booking fee within 24 hours.
- No refund for no show.
