



What are the ages, abilities and dates of the camps?

Freeride Camps are designed for **beginner and intermediate riders (Level 2/3)**.

Camp Schedule (Mondays & Tuesdays)

Kids Camps: Ages 8–12

- **July:** 6 & 7 | 20 & 21
- **August:** 3 & 4 | 17 & 18

Youth Camps: Ages 13–16

- **July:** 13 & 14 | 27 & 28
- **August:** 10 & 11 | 24 & 25

What skills will be learned?

Skills are tailored to the ability level of each group and may include:

- Body position and bike-body separation
- Braking and descending techniques
- Cornering and switchbacks
- Standing and crouched riding positions
- Front-wheel lifts and pedalling control
- Straight-line riding
- Introduction to elevated features and small airs

What is the cost? How long is the camp?

- **\$339 per participant (+ GST)**
- **2-day camp | 10:00 am to 3:00 pm**
- Includes a supervised one-hour lunch break
- Maximum group ratio: **7 participants per coach**

What is included in the camp? What should participants bring?

Camp pricing includes professional instruction and lift tickets.

Bike rentals can be reserved, and camp participants receive 15% off.

Participants must bring:

- A well-tuned bike with **disc brakes**
- **Full-face helmet**
- **Arm and leg protection**
- Riding gloves and flat-soled biking shoes (recommended)
- Hydration pack or water bottle
- Packed lunch, snacks, and sunscreen

Where and when do I show up?

Please meet your coach at **10:00 am** at the Summer Adventure School meeting area beside the **Bike Skills Park**. Arrive ready to ride.

Lift tickets can be picked up in advance at **Guest Services in the Main Plaza**.

If renting equipment, please arrive **45 minutes early** to allow time for waivers and bike setup. Pre-booking rentals is strongly recommended due to limited availability.

Will campers have to wait in lift lines?

No. Summer Adventure School participants use a **priority lift line** to maximize riding time.

Coaches assist with loading and unloading lifts. Riders must be **4 ft 7 in (140 cm)** tall to load the lift independently.

What is the cancellation policy?

- **7+ days before camp start:** Full refund or rebooking minus a \$29 administration fee
- **Within 7 days of camp start:** No refunds

A minimum of **4 participants** is required for the camp to run. If this minimum is not met, a full refund will be issued.

Do parents or guardians need to sign waivers?

Yes. A parent or legal guardian must complete the required waivers for all participants aged **15 and under**.
