



### Camp Details

Campers meet at the **Lizard Ranger Centre** (Griz Kids Centre during the winter).

- Camp activities run from **10:00 am to 3:30 pm**
- Early drop-off available from **9:00 am** with supervised crafts and games

At check-in, camp leaders will confirm emergency contact details and any important information about your child. Please label all personal belongings.

### 5-Day Camps

- Offered Monday to Friday each week throughout July and August
- \$499 per child (+ GST)

### 3-Day Camps

- Offered Monday to Wednesday each week throughout July and August
- \$329 per child (+ GST)

All camps are designed for children aged **6 to 12 years**. Pricing includes lift access, and the maximum group ratio is **10 participants to 1 leader**.

### What are the dates of the camps?

#### 3-Day Camps (Monday to Wednesday)

- **July:** 6–8, 13–15, 20–22, 27–29
- **August:** 3–5, 10–12, 17–19, 24–26

#### 5-Day Camps (Monday to Friday)

- **July:** 6–10, 13–17, 20–24, 27–31
- **August:** 3–7, 10–14, 17–21, 24–28

### What activities are included in the camp?

Camp programming is inspired by the **British Columbia Conservation Foundation's WildSafeBC Rangers program**.

Participants will learn about:

- Wildlife awareness and mountain safety
- Leave No Trace principles

- Orienteering and navigation
- Trail exploration and outdoor adventure

Kids will receive an activity booklet and take part in interactive games as they work toward becoming a **Junior Ranger**.

### **What should participants bring?**

Children should be prepared for all-mountain weather and changing conditions.

We recommend bringing:

- Hydration pack or water bottle
- Peanut-free lunch and snacks
- Sunscreen and insect repellent
- Rain jacket and extra clothing layers
- Sturdy hiking shoes (no open-toed or heeled footwear)

### **Can I purchase lunch for my child?**

Lunch is not available for purchase, as some days include eating lunch on the mountain.

Please pack a **peanut-free lunch**, snacks, and plenty of water. Water refill stations are available throughout the day.

### **Will campers have to wait in lift lines?**

No. The Summer Adventure School uses a **priority lift line** to maximize activity and learning time.

Staff will assist with lift loading and unloading. Children must be **4 ft 7 in (140 cm)** tall to load the lift independently.

### **What is the cancellation policy?**

- **7 or more days before camp start:** Full refund or rebooking, minus a \$29 administration fee
- **Within 7 days of camp start:** No refunds

### **Do parents or guardians need to sign waivers?**

Yes. A parent or legal guardian must complete the required waivers for all participants aged **15 and under**.
