

FERNIE ALPINE RESORT – BIKE PARK TRAIL DESCRIPTIONS

Trail Name	#	Type	Description
Silk / Manchuria	1 / 2	Multi-Use	Multi-use trail network. Double-track road.
Boom	3	Multi-Use	Wide, scenic fireroad trail for those brand new to off-pavement biking. Gentle grades through the cedar forest with great views.
Cedar Trail	4	Multi-Use	Similar to Boom Trail. Brings riders back into the base along a gravel road.
View Trail	5	Multi-Use	Fireroad access trails, used to reach Provincial Park.
Deer Trail	6	Freeride/Flow	Begins as a wide gravel fire road before transitioning into a wide trail. Small berms, rolls and gentle grades snaking through the forest.
Will Power	7	Technical	One of our original DH trails, Fast and fall-line through the forest. A racer’s favorite for its technical riding challenges.
Trac III	8	Technical	Similar to Will Power, but a bit rockier with loose soil
Playground	9	Technical	Technical corners and multiple line options with a few drops and jumps.
Case Closed	9A	Technical	Steep sections into supported corners and off-camber roots make this a challenging, fun ride.
Duff Dynasty	10	Freeride/Flow	Gentle, smooth trail full of twists, turns, rolls, and bridges through cedar forest. A great trail for families and kids of all ages!
Kodiak Karnage	11	Technical	Fast, steep, and loose. This is a committing trail for experts only.
Gorbie Loop	12	Multi-Use	Fire road through Cedar Bowl providing access to Provincial Park. Long uphill are required to return to base area.
GT Racer	13	Freeride/Flow	Hand-built meandering trail through the cedar forest just off Mr. Berms. Good trail for green riders looking to practice riding berms and maintaining speed and flow.
Aggravated Assault	14	Technical	Big brother to Hollow Tree. A singletrack trail with some wood features.
Double Creek / Double Creek Ext.	15 & 15A	Multi-Use	X-Country-style trail that traverses the lower mountain through shaded forest. Scenic bridges over creeks.
Ben’s Big Rig	17	Freeride/Flow	Begins with small berms and gentle traverses. Access at the halfway point to Deer Trail or continue to the lower section with larger berms and access to Honey Bee/Eville.
Yellowjacket	18	Freeride /Flow	NEW for 2026! A blue progression jump trail that sends riders down a shaded forest and across a creek to join with Holo Bike & Eville Strikes Back.
Rubber Ducky	19	Freeride /Flow	You can find a black flow trail, loaded with advanced features and mega berms. JUMP SKILLS REQUIRED.
Monorail	20	Freeride /Flow	Short, playful jump trail bringing riders into the base area.
Phat Larry’s	21	Technical	Classic steep singletrack meandering through cedar ravine. Steeps and drops with a flowy finish.
Hollow Tree	22	Technical	Medium grade and full of natural terrain features such as roots, rocks, and rolls.
Holo Bike	23	Technical	Neighbors with Phat Larry’s but offers gentler grades.
Alternate Flight Pattern	24	Technical	Gain some altitude on the largest man-made wood features at the resort.
Lil’Miss Buffit	26	Technical	A great singletrack side route paralleling Cedar Trail.
Bike Thief	27	Technical	Technical corners, off-camber roots, and rocky sections with lots of natural ebb and flow. At the halfway point, there are great views up the valley. A short upper section (entry off Trespass Trail to Diamond Back) is rated double black due to mandatory drops and techy rooty corners. The remainder of the trail is rated single black.
Neverland	28	Technical	Technical but flowy descent with lots of natural terrain features.
Upper & Lower Rumplestumpskin	29A & B	Technical (upper) Freeride/Flow (lower)	A technical old-school DH trail featuring rock rolls, tight corners, and fun forest sections. When you reach the lower section at Rock Landing, the trail has technical terrain features and jumps.
Leave Me A Loam	29C	Technical	Accessed off Lower Rumplestumpskin – Fernie’s fresh hand-built line in the forest.
Megasaurus	30	Multi-Use	Fire road traversing across mountain bowls. If the pedaling doesn’t take your breath away, the views will. Rated black diamond (advanced)
BC Cup	31	Technical	From Diamond Back corner, this trail drops, takes a fast and direct line through steep old-growth cedar trees.
Top Gun	32	Freeride /Flow	One of Fernie’s most loved trails with fast, flowy berms and jumps. All features can be rolled over, providing a great option or transitional trail for groups with varying ability levels.
Top Gun Ext.	32A	Freeride/Flow	A machine-built fast way to get to Top Gun.
Mr Berms	33	Freeride/Flow	A great warm-up trail to get the blood flowing and the suspension moving. Cruises across a ski run in a series of berms and rollers. A great introduction to blue trails for the beginner rider ready for a new challenge.
Bin Logdin	34	Freeride/Flow	Similar to Eville but on steroids! Fast, flowy berms and jumps.
Eville Strikes Back	35	Freeride/Flow	A green flow trail that weaves in open forests back to the Holo Bike connector. It has small jumps and berms to help the newer rider build confidence and flow.
Ewok	36	Technical	Tight trail snakes through the forest with a series of low ladders and bridges to test your technical skills and balance.
TNT	37A	Technical	A technically challenging trail through a shady forest with a few natural drops and rooty sections.
Communication Breakdown	37B	Freeride/Flow	A revamp of the lowest TNT and a big sister to Bln Logdin. You will find machine-built jumps and rollers to porgress your flow trail and jump riding skills.
Rockstar	37C	Freeride/Flow	A short technical section ending wiht a long wooden ramp down to the parking lot.
Cats Pyjamas	38	Technical	Located on the notorious Kodiak run, and is just as steep and technical as its neighbor, Kodiak Karnage. If you love surfing sustained steep and root-filled chutes, this is the trail for you.
Lizard Lane	39	Freeride /Flow	A flowy jump trail through large cedar trees near the base. A great way to end your ride and work on jump and berms skills.
